During the water crisis, violence in Flint began to rise. Homes faced an increase in domestic shootings increased, and gangs formed. The lead didn't just poison our pipes - it poisoned the minds of our people. Years

later, our youth are still living with the effects of being victim to poison and living with parents who have been poisoned.

Teens are just trying to enjoy life, build friendships, and find their place in the world—but too often, that search ends in tragedy.

Female victims have reached an all time high. Our Teens deserve safe spaces designed for them.

Teens come home from school to streets filled with fear—where a last name or who they're seen with can cost them their life. Girls are being shot just for being connected to the wrong boy.

They deserve more than survival. They deserve a safe space to just be teens. We have a plan—and it's working.

At Project Saved Jesus Loves You, we foster strong relationships among our P.S. Social Hub members. Teens gather weekly to connect, talk through real issues, resolve conflict, and seek forgiveness through God's Word, partnered therapists, and mentors -allowing them to enjoy outings with peace of mind and purpose.

We focus on building teen leaders who serve as ambassadors, positively influencing their peers. We reach the teens searching for more but surrounded by less—equipping them to lead, so they can lift the next.

Our youth ambassadors keep us informed with real-time updates, praise reports, and social media trends—helping us better serve over 80 active members and grow as mentors and parents.

In just one year, we've grown and created successful events that impacted over 120 teens and over 250 parents and their family.



FLINT, Mich. (WJRT) - A high-energy youth event focused on music, mental health, and community took place Sunday in Downtown Flint.

Teens from across Genesee County are gathering at Buckham Alley for the UNMUTE: End of Summer Concert — a free event designed to empower young people through music, conversation, and connection.

The event was hosted by Project Saved Jesus Loves You and Dayna McGhee, with support from Genesee Health System, Flint Registry, and several other local organizations.



In just our first year, we have exceeded expectations—surpassing our initial goals. We've built a thriving community with over 400 subscribers and 80 active members in our online database. Each week, we connect with more than 40 teens through consistent meetups, fostering trust, leadership, and growth.

We have already successfully secured grant funding and raised over \$27,000 in support since March 2025. Our Funding cycle has ended and we are still growing. Currently, we are in development of the P.S. Social Hub—a first-of-its-kind, teen-driven facility designed to serve as a safe space, creative hub, and leadership incubator for Flint youth.
